flies over to investigate.



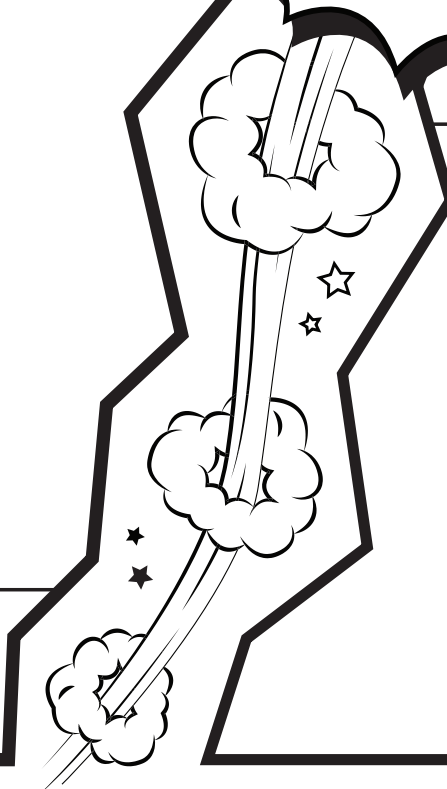
Little Fly is snapped up by the flytrap's big mouth.
